the students that we can accommodate with a small group outing. At the last minute we may learn about a
special event that could be available to our students or have tickets donated or want to take part in other
trips that are judged appropriate given weather and other circumstances. In those instances, we will also
try to give you advance notice, but it may only be a phone call.
I understand and acknowledge that despite the school's precaution and supervision, participation in the
activities may involve some inherent risks of injury or property damage greater than that associated with a
classroom-based activity, including risks associated with transportation by bus, and I consent to my
child's participation with that knowledge.
I agree to indemnify HMS School for Children with Cerebral Palsy for any costs or expenses arising out
of my child's participation in the activities including the cost of any medical care given my child or any
expenses or fees incurred in any lawsuit arising as a result of any damage or injuries caused by or to my
child in the course of his or her participation in this activity.
Trips planned as part of the day school program are planned well in advance and require individual
signatures per trip. You will be notified separately by your child's teacher of the classroom or therapy
field trip plans ahead of the date of any trip.
